## Presentation Surrey Phase II Expansion Project

Zahir Dossa, Project Manager and Ron Beaton and Tony Cowan of Downs Archambault Architects presented the new model for the Phase II Expansion advising that the design is approaching the 80% completion stage. The landscape scheme and presentation drawings of the Project will be presented to the City of Surrey's Advisory Design Panel at the end of October. A submission of the 80% package together with the Cost Consultant's Estimate will be made to the Ministry on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of November as part of the Ministry's project approval process. This schedule will allow for the Main Building Contract Tender to be issued in the first week of January 1998.
